From April 2023 to June 2023, as part of the W4RES awareness raising campaign for the Italian HUB, APRE carried out a collaboration with SHE IS A SCIENTIST, an Italian association launched in 2017 to enhance the contribution of women to science. The initiative was called "W4SHE", from the portmanteau between the names of the project and the association: it is a campaign to share role models, success stories and examples of women involved in the energy and RHC sectors.


